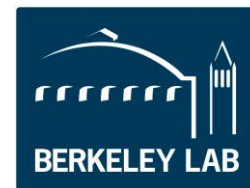

What is eProject Builder (ePB)?

- Free web-based ESPC project data management system
- Developed and maintained by LBNL for U.S. DOE
- Currently houses 400+ projects: federal, state, local, university, K-12
- ePB enables ESCOs and their customers to securely:
 - Upload and track project and M&V information for the life of the contract
 - Quickly generate data for project and portfolio reports
 - Develop project scenarios using standardized calculations
 - Benchmark new ESPC projects against historical project data



ePB Benefits

- **Secure centralized online database** for data preservation, analysis, and tracking over time
- **Standardized data collection** across ESCOs and markets
- **Enables data-based analysis** for reporting ESPC success stories
- **Archiving** of modifications and additional documents
- **Varying and transferable levels of access** to provide authorized users access to relevant data
- **Simple, user-friendly tool** that requires minimal time from customers
- **Customer confidence and empowerment** via transparency, 3rd-party standardization, and ready access to data



What's New with ePB?

New Features and Updates

- “Super Viewer” functionality enables agency or organization-level read-only access to groups of projects
- 70 new and legacy state/local/educational projects in ePB
- 3-state MEASURES team has evaluated and is using ePB

Forthcoming (Fall 2016)

- More detailed pricing schedules
- NAESCO accreditation feature
 - ESCOs will submit projects for national accreditation via ePB
- Analytics and reporting feature
 - Drag and drop pivot tables + graph outputs for advanced project/program-level analysis and reporting
