

2010 – 24 buildings and \$9.3 million



- 2014 120 buildings and \$26.2 million
 - Corrections HVAC, lighting
 - PARC lighting converted to LED
 - Libraries lighting, noise reduction, HVAC
 - Fire Stations Occupancy/CO2 sensors, HVAC, lighting, gas infrared in bays

2014 Project, Continued

- LMPD and Zoo HVAC, lighting, controls
- Parks solar heating at Meagher pool
- Water Efficiency
 - 57 million gallons
- Sewer reductions



Annual Environmental Impact

- 19,900 metric tons of CO2 reduced
- Equivalent to planting
 1 million trees

S)

- Equivalent to removing 4,100 vehicles
- 46,300 barrels of oil not burned
