

# Minnesota Department of Corrections

#### Good Candidate for ESPC

- 20% state owned building sq. ft.
- 6 million sq. ft.
- 334 Buildings
- 64% of buildings could save energy (B3)
- \$7 million on utilities/year (B3)



## Expressed Before ESPC Accelerator

- No up front capital for facility upgrades / Reliance on legislature
- Lack of experience with ESPC
- Lack of trust in ESPC
- Lack of utility meters/data



Community Based Social Marketing Activities

- Map decision making process
- Link stakeholders to decisions
- Document known barriers
- ID gaps in barrier/benefit knowledge
- Gather barrier/benefit data
- Develop strategies



### Discovered Needs and Barriers

- Capital Resources are segregated from Financial Services
- Importance of educating different stakeholder groups
  - Physical Plant Directors
  - Finance Directors
  - Wardens
- Risk averse / Take action similar to other correctional facilities



#### Customized Peer Workshops

- Conduct 3 separate stakeholder group workshops
  - Physical Plant Directors
  - Finance Directors
  - Wardens

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- Develop agenda addressing needs/barriers
- Identify peer speakers that have "been there – done that"
